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

This track, along with others from the album *Primitive Love*, set the foundation for Latin pop as we know it today. It's an assertion that holds true even 35 years after its release.

Before Primitive Love, Latin pop lacked a unified definition and had minimal presence in the US. However, all of that changed in 1985. Gloria Estefan and her bandmate/producer/husband Emilio Estefan Jr. made a global impact with their music.

The concept was simple: Play the music that resonates with you and find success. This motivated Emilio to form the Miami Latin Boys in 1975. Two years later, during a wedding performance, Gloria Fajardo approached him, expressing her desire to sing some Cuban numbers with the band. Impressed by her talent, Estefan invited Fajardo and her cousin to join the group, resulting in the formation of Miami Sound Machine. By 1978, Estefan and Fajardo were married and on their way to greater achievements.

The two developed a winning formula: Modern pop infused with cutting-edge production and sprinkled with Latin music elements. Additionally, they focused on crafting exceptional songs. "I wasn't thinking about the market," said Emilio. "Gloria was the one who told me that to achieve success, we needed our unique sound. We couldn't imitate anyone." This mindset birthed "Conga." In addition to its incredibly catchy melody, the song introduced a fresh sound without radically altering any genre. It reached Number 10 on the Hot 100 pop chart and topped the Latin chart, while also charting on the Dance and R&B charts.

Primitive Love marked the pinnacle for Miami Sound Machine, but the Estefans were just getting started. Their subsequent album, 1987's Let It Loose, was credited to "Gloria Estefan and Miami Sound Machine," as Emilio was the only original member remaining. Spiritual successors to "Conga" like "Rhythm Is Gonna Get You" and "1-2-3" thrived on the charts, but it was the ballads that propelled them to a new level of success.

Gloria and Emilio didn't create Latin pop in their image. Instead, they understood what worked and produced outstanding music. Their approach to appealing to a broader audience remained effective for years, only recently witnessing a slight shift towards rhythms and vocal cadences that fans now crave.

Nevertheless, Primitive Love – a bold move by a couple determined to succeed through their love of music – still serves as the blueprint.

Since arriving in 2005, The Playhouse has tripled its audience, growing from an acclaimed Summer Stock theater into one of America's preeminent year-round regional theaters, with productions staged in multiple states. During Brad's stewardship, The Playhouse has garnered numerous awards and honors including the Moss Hart Trophy for Outstanding Achievement in the American Theatre, and multiple IRNE and Broadway World awards. Beyond having great pride in overseeing more than 94 Playhouse productions, Brad is closely involved in the development of America's theatrical canon through the Ogunquit Playhouse New Works Program, guiding the curation and development of new theatrical experiences, including Frida The Musical, Mommie Dearest The Musical, Heartbreak Hotel, Mystic Pizza, Christmas in Connecticut, Mr. Holland's Opus, and The Nutty Professor.
